

About the Schools Program

1. What is the Netball World Cup Sydney 2027 Schools Program?

The Netball World Cup Sydney 2027 (NWC2027) Schools Program gives primary and secondary students across Australia opportunities to connect with the pinnacle international event in netball through live tournament experiences and classroom learning.

Schools can participate through:

- **Schools Excursion Experiences** – attend selected weekday NWC2027 competition sessions in Sydney.
- **Classroom Engagement** – access curriculum-linked educator resources and tournament-inspired classroom activities available nationally through Netball Australia's Teacher Ambassador Program (TAP).

2. When and where is Netball World Cup Sydney 2027?

NWC2027 will take place in Sydney from **25 August to 5 September 2027**, bringing together **16 of the world's best netball nations for 64 matches across 12 days** to compete to be crowned Netball World Cup champions.

3. Who can participate in the Schools Program?

The NWC2027 Schools Program is designed for **primary and secondary students of all genders and abilities**.

Students do not need to play netball or have previous experience of the sport, and schools do not need to be affiliated with a netball club.

Schools are encouraged to give students of all genders the opportunity to experience the world's best female athletes competing at the highest level, while exploring teamwork, leadership, representation, international cultures and global connection.

Schools Excursion Program

4. What will students experience through the Schools Excursion Program?

Students will have the opportunity to experience NWC2027 live in Sydney as part of an educational excursion, including:

- attendance at a selected NWC2027 competition session;
- curriculum-linked excursion materials; and
- supporting classroom resources.

Further details about the excursion experience will be provided before bookings open.

5. Which schools can attend NWC2027 in Sydney?

Any primary or secondary school able to travel to Sydney can register its interest.

While the Schools Excursion Program is expected to be particularly accessible to schools in NSW and the ACT, regional and interstate schools are also welcome to attend.

6. Which NWC2027 competition sessions will be available to schools?

School excursion opportunities are planned for **selected weekday competition sessions between 25 August and 1 September 2027**.

Specific sessions, matches and availability will be announced before bookings open.

7. When will school excursion bookings open?

Bookings are planned to open in **early 2027**.

Schools that submit an Expression of Interest will receive priority updates and be among the first notified when bookings open.

8. Will there be dedicated school pricing for the Schools Excursion Program?

Yes. **Dedicated school pricing will be available for selected weekday NWC2027 competition sessions to help make the tournament accessible to school groups.**

Full pricing, teacher and accompanying adult ticket allocations and booking information will be provided before bookings open in early 2027.

Classroom activities and educator resources

9. How can schools participate if they can't attend NWC2027 in Sydney?

Schools across Australia can participate through curriculum-linked educator resources and tournament-inspired classroom activities, connecting students with NWC2027, its competing nations and international netball from their classroom.

10. What classroom activities and educator resources will be available?

Resources are being developed around themes including:

- health and physical education;
- teamwork and leadership;
- women's sport and representation;
- international cultures and cultural understanding; and
- the nations and communities participating in NWC2027.

Further details will be released as resources are developed.

11. Will the educator resources be curriculum-linked?

Yes. Resources will include curriculum links across relevant learning areas, in line with the Australian Curriculum V9 (which can be adapted to PDHPE and other state curriculums), with specific curriculum links provided with the resources.

12. When and how will teachers be able to access the resources?

NWC2027 educator resources and classroom activities will be available nationally through **Netball Australia's Teacher Ambassador Program (TAP)**.

Teacher Ambassadors will receive NWC2027 Schools Program updates and resources as they become available.

Expression of Interest

13. Why should our school register an Expression of Interest?

Registering ensures your school receives priority Schools Program updates and is among the first notified when school excursion bookings open in early 2027.

14. Does submitting an Expression of Interest guarantee excursion tickets?

No. An Expression of Interest is **not a ticket booking and does not guarantee tickets or availability for a particular session.**

Schools that register will receive priority information about booking opportunities.

15. Who can submit an Expression of Interest and how do we register?

Teachers, school leaders, sports coordinators and other relevant school representatives can register on behalf of their school.
